POLAR BEARS

NUUK

**SCORESBY SUND** Scoresby Sund is the largest fjord system in the world. A winding extension of the Greenland Sea, it stretches 68 miles into the eastern terrain of Greenland. The sound was first sailed by English explorer William Scoresby in 1822.



Qaqortoq has been inhabited since the Viking era and is now the largest town in South Greenland with just over 3,200 residents.
